ABSOLYTE® AGP AND AGX

PHOTOVOLTAIC AND ALTERNATIVE ENERGY WARRANTY

LIMITED WARRANTY: Stryten Energy warrants to the Original User ("User"), subject to the Conditions and Limitations described below, that an ABSOLYTE AGP® or ABSOLYTE AGX® stationary battery, when used in photovoltaic support service within North and South America ("Covered Battery") will be free from defects in materials or workmanship for a period of "m" years (see chart below) from the date of shipment ("Warranty Period"). Stryten Energy also warrants to the User, subject to the Conditions and Limitations described below, that a Covered Battery will furnish at least 80% of its rated capacity during the Warranty Period. The User shall promptly report any alleged failures to meet these warranties to Stryten Energy and permit examination by Stryten Energy service personnel. If Stryten Energy finds the Covered Battery has failed to meet these warranties during the Warranty Period, Stryten Energy will, at its option, either repair the Covered Battery or provide a replacement, FOB Stryten Energy factory. The original battery will become the property of Stryten Energy.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. The Covered Battery must retain the bar code regarding product information in a readable condition.
2. The Covered Battery must be handled, stored, and installed in accordance with Stryten Energy's published instructions for the Covered Battery.
3. The upper voltage level setting of the overcharge protection controller is adjusted for a daily depth of discharge in the following way:

Table with 4 columns: Daily Depth of Discharge Range, Upper Voltage Setting at 25°C, Upper Voltage Setting at 30°C, Upper Voltage Setting at 35°C. Rows include discharge ranges from 0-2%, 2-5%, and above 5%.

- 4. In the case that the average daily temperature in the area of use for any year is established:

Table with 2 columns: Average Daily Temperature, 'm' is equal to: Rows show temperature limits (25°C, 30°C, 35°C) and corresponding warranty periods (7, 5, 4 years).

- 5. Customer shall maintain complete annual records regarding the temperature, voltage, conditions of use, and maintenance performed, including initial charge and equalize charging, as per the Stryten Energy Installation and Operations manual and must promptly provide these records to Stryten Energy upon request.
6. The User will be responsible for all labor, transportation and shipping charges for all repair work and for the shipment of replacement batteries or parts, under the Limited Warranty provided above.
7. Repairs or modifications made to the Covered Battery without prior written consent of Stryten Energy, or movement of the Covered Battery from the original point of installation, will void this Limited Warranty.

LIMITATIONS ON LIMITED WARRANTY: This Limited Warranty is the only warranty provided by Stryten Energy. THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS SET FORTH IN THIS DOCUMENT ARE EXCLUSIVE AND IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED, IMPLIED, OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. This Limited Warranty may not be assigned or transferred by the User and it sets forth the exclusive remedy for all claims, damages, or losses arising out of defect in or failure of any Covered Battery. In no event shall Stryten Energy be liable for consequential or incidental losses or damages under any theory of liability, except to the extent that this limitation is found to be unenforceable under applicable state law or other law. Some jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so this exclusion may not apply to you. This limited warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights, which vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.
